主講者簡介 Speakers' Biography



Prof Jimmy Zhang

Prof Zhang obtained his Bachelor and Master Degrees from the Gangsu Agricultural University. He has over 20 years of research experience in grassland ecology and turf science. He then switched to turf construction and management after spending 20 months as a visiting scholar in the Sports Turf Research Institute in the UK in 1998. He is currently an associate professor/research fellow in the South China Agricultural University. He has been actively involved in the construction and maintenance of various important sports fields, including the 11th Asian Games in Beijing in 1990, 9th National Games in Guangzhou in 2001, and the 16th Asian Games in Guangzhou in 2010. He has obtained a number of prizes and awards in the construction and management of sports turf in China.



Mr Ricky Aitken

Mr Aitken has been working in the turf industry for the past 18 years. He started his career working on Lawn Bowling Greens in Tasmania, Australia where he completed a four year trade certificate in turf management. He then progressed on to work for the local government authority where he managed the Cricket Grounds and Australian Rules football grounds for the next 7 years. During this time he completed a turf diploma through the North Melbourne Institute of Tafe. In 2002, he left Tasmania to take up a position with the Hong Kong Cricket Club where he took up the role of grounds manager. He is also a consultant for the Kowloon Cricket Club and Hong Kong Cricket Association. He has been working in Hong Kong for the past 8 years where he operates his own Company Leisure Turf and Landscape Limited.



Mr Ronald R. Carlyle

Mr Carlyle graduated in golf course management, Horry Georgetown Technical College, South Carolina, USA. He has been working as an independent turf management consultant. Currently, he is the senior superintendent of the Miramar Golf and Country Club as well as the agronomic consultant for Yunghan Golf Club and Chiau Shih-Ilan in Taiwan. He is specialized in golf course maintenance, construction, renovations, grassing, grow-ins and professional tournament preparation. He has practiced in developing and implementing regional and international renovation programs for various major organizations in Southeast Asia, China, Taiwan and the USA. He also serves as an inspector under the International Turfgrass Genetic Assurance Program (ITGAP), USA.



Ms Christine Wai-yee Chan

Ms Chan is the golf course superintendent at the Jockey Club Kau Sai Chau Public Golf Course and President of South China Turf Manager Association since 2008, as well as an international member of Golf Course Superintendent of America Association. She has 15 years experience in turfgrass industry. She graduated with a Master degree in turf management from the University of Sydney and a Bachelor degree in Applied Biology. She is currently managing a 54 holes public golf course in Hong Kong with a team of 83 staff. She has experience in managing warm season grasses and has involved in daily maintenance, construction of East Course and renovation projects. She also prepares golf courses for professional players and amateur player tournaments.



Dr Eric Lee

Dr Lee obtained his BSc in Biology from CUHK and then his PhD from the University of California at Santa Cruz. He was a Mercer Fellow in the Arnold Arboretum, Harvard University. He has been the head greens keeper of the Hong Kong Golf Club, tracks manager of the Hong Kong Jockey Club, resident turf specialist and senior tracks manager of the Singapore Turf Club. Dr. Lee has been working in the turf industry continuously for the past 35 years. His foot prints covered nearly all the major turf institutes in Hong Kong and adjacent areas. He was also involved in the planning stage on the construction of the first golf course in China and subsequent consultation on course management. He was labeled as probably the most knowledgeable turfgrass expert in that region of the world by the USGA's official publication "Turf Management" as early as in 1985. Recently he is a senior honorary research fellow in the School of Life Sciences, CUHK and the president of the Institute of Horticulture Science of Hong Kong.



Mr Pako Ip

Mr Ip obtained his BSc from the University of Saskatchewan, Canada, in agriculture, specializing in horticultural science. He is the tracks manager of the Hong Kong Jockey Club Racing since 1996. He has been involved in the grassing of the redeveloped Happy Valley course (1995), installation of the Riverside gallop track (1996) and its conversion into a sand footing (2009), as well as the design, construction and maintenance of the Olympics Grass Arena (2006 to 2010) and Olympics Cross Country Training Track inside Penfold Park (2006-2008). He is specialized in sand profile construction and management, organic accumulation and ageing management of rootzone, plant growth regulation with hormones and their inhibitors, turfgrass transition dynamics and nematode management.



Mr Lee Sellars

Mr Sellars is a Florida native with 15 years experience in managing turfgrass in Hong Kong and China. As a graduate of the Pennsylvania State University in turfgrass management, Mr Sellars is an active member of the Golf Course Superintendents Association of America (GCSAA), who brings over 20 years experience in all facets of golf course construction, project management and operations. In 1995 he joined Discovery Bay Golf Club in Hong Kong and served as a golf course manager. He was instrumental in introducing and successfully maintaining the first certified TifEagle bermudagrass in Asia. Most recently he served as a director of agronomy at XiLi Golf and Country Club in Shenzhen. In 2010 he established Premierturf Services, a Hong Kong based company providing project management, agronomic consultation and soil testing services to esteemed clients throughout Asia. He also serves as an Inspector under the International Turfgrass Genetic Assurance Program (ITGAP), USA.



Mr Kevin Feng

Mr Kevin Feng graduated in 2004 with a degree in horticulture from the China Agricultural University. He has wide experience in sod farming and marketing in China. Mr Fong pioneered the production of certified turfgrass production in Southern China. He is now the general manager of Sino-Green Turf Co Ltd which covers 40% of the market share of new golf course projects especially in warm season grasses. Recently a few ITGAP certified warm-season turfgrasses produced from his Hainan-based production nurseries were being used by several major turf institutes in Hong Kong. As a global certified turfgrass grower, Sino-Green is committed for the provision of highest quality, genetically pure and uniform turfgrasses, effective establishment programs and on-going maintenance services by their certified agronomists.



Mr Simon Chan

Mr Chan graduated in mechanical engineering at the Morrison Hill Technical Institute. He switched to private enterprise in automatic irrigation system at the Shatin Race Course one year after working in the Electrical and Mechanical Department since graduation. Since then, he has been responsible for installation projects for the Hong Kong Sports Institute, Happy Valley Race Course, Hong Kong Golf Club, Kau Sai Chau Golf Club, Macau Golf and Country Club and Macau Jockey Club. He has also been involved in various large-scale sports centers and golf clubs in Guangzhou, Panyu, Conghua, Dongguan, Shanghai, Chongqing and Beijing.



Prof Bau-Yuen Hu

Prof Hu received his PhD in Plant Pathology and Microbiology from the National Taiwan University. He is currently an assistant professor in the Department of Biological Science and Technology at the China University of Science and Technology, Taiwan, and is specialized in fermentative technology, medicinal fungi and biopesticides. He is actively engaged in the control of brown root rot fungi using tree ectomycorrhizae, integration of tree hopsital and tree diseases, mass production of mycelium from Antrodia camphorata, study of Chaetomium in Taiwan. He has published 20 papers on soil and tree fungi, and six books on plant pests and diseases.



Prof Chiu obtained her BSc and MPhil in Biology, CUHK. She then went to the University of Manchester and got her PhD. She is currently an associate professor in the School of Life Sciences, CUHK. She has served as the keynote/invited speaker in various international mycological meetings, organized various international mycological conferences, provided consultancy and technical services, e.g. mold, mushroom and toadstool identification; mold survey; mushroom breeding; cultivation and quality assurance of mushroom products.
